A student is eligible to apply for the \$500.00 scholarship if, at the time of application:

- Is enrolled in a bachelor or associate degree program.
- Has completed at least 6 credits of course work that is developmental, English language learning (ESL, ELL, ESOL, etc.), stretch (i.e., extending beyond one academic term), and/or co-remediation
- Has earned at least 24 credits.
- Has a cumulative GPA of at least 3.20.
- Will be a continuing student enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits in the Spring 2019 semester (graduating students are ineligible to apply).

1. An official transcript of your college work.
2. A letter of recommendation from a college faculty member, college professional staff member, or college administrator.
3. A typed/double-spaced essay addressing one of the following writing prompts:
 - i. Developmental education's role in academic success and the impact of developmental course work on you.
 - ii. Developmental education's role in providing educational access for underprepared students.
 - iii. The role of developmental education in student success framed by your educational story.
4. Evidence of enrollment in coursework at the home institution for the semester following the awarding of the scholarship. (Verification of spring semester enrollment from student's Registrar's Office must be submitted to LAANE Treasurer before scholarship check will be issued to student.)
